



**BELT AND ROAD INITIATIVE FORUM**  
**Fourth (4th) Session on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

This is a forum of a series of four bimonthly sessions with a theme of “Belt and Road Initiative” (BRI), which is jointly organized by The Hong Kong Logistics Management Staff Association (HKLMSA), C.Y. Tung International Centre for Maritime Studies, PolyU (ICMS) and the Hong Kong Seamen Union (HKSU). It employs the Interdisciplinary Learning/Back-to-Basics (IDL/B2B) methodology and the sessions are conducted in an open forum case study with interactive question and answer (Q&A) discussions. It is a platform for those from all sectors of the Hong Kong economy, businessmen, eminent professionals, academics and even students, to explore what BRI offers them, and to share their expertise and valuable experience in realizing the opportunities through application of the BRI Triangle Theory of “Politics, Economics & Culture”.

The **Fourth (4th) Session** of the **BRI Forum** is on the topic “**The Role & Opportunities for Maritime & Other Service Providers under BRI**” (Session II).

It will examine the role of education and training services provided by institutions and professional bodies in Hong Kong, as the Logistics & Maritime Studies (LMS) and other programmes of the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, to produce professionals to seize opportunities presented by the BRI and GBA to Hong Kong.

The Moderators for this 4th Session will be Mr. Raymond Wong Tak Chiu, Chairman of the Institute of Seatransport, and Prof. Lu Chin-Shan of Hong Kong Polytechnic University/ICMS, with other members of the Panel of Moderators and Advisors in attendance.

The Guest Moderators will be Dr. Yang Dong of Hong Kong Polytechnic University and the alumni Ms Audrey Shen who will present a case study on how she applied her studies to her work.

Mr. Raymond Wong, the first Chinese qualified fellow of the UK Association of Average Adjusters, will brief us on the development of Average Adjusting in Hong Kong since 1945, and discuss on the topic “Hong Kong as an International Average Adjusting Centre?”, and how this profession in Hong Kong may stand with the benefit of BRI.

There will be a panel of young professionals who will discuss in an open forum Q&A the case study “BRI & GBA: HK as an International Logistics Hub and International Education & Training Centre under BRI & the future for young professionals in HK”. The panel consists of members as Mr. Adrian C.C. Lam (Technical), Mr. Vincent Y.G. Yeung (Legal), Mr. Billy W.H. Yip (Freight Forwarding), Ms Maggie S.M. Wong (Student), Ms Biggie Yung (Port Captain), Mr. Terrence Sun (Marine Insurance) and Mr. Steven Yan (P&I).
