



## **BELT AND ROAD INITIATIVE FORUM II First (1<sup>st</sup>) Session on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2019**

This is the second series of the Belt and Road Initiative Forum (BRIF) of four bimonthly sessions, which is jointly organized by The Hong Kong Logistics Management Staff Association (HKLMSA), C.Y. Tung International Centre for Maritime Studies, PolyU (ICMS) and the Hong Kong Seamen Union (HKSU). It employs the Interdisciplinary Learning, Back-to-Basics and Interdisciplinary Learning Interlink (IDL/B2B/ILI) Methodology and the sessions are conducted in an open forum case study format with interactive question and answer (Q&A) discussions. It is a platform for those from all sectors of the Hong Kong economy, businessmen, eminent professionals, academics and even students, to explore what BRI offers them, and to share their expertise and valuable experience in realizing the opportunities through application of the BRI Triangle Theory of “Politics, Economics & Culture”.

The **Inaugural (1<sup>st</sup>) Session of the BRI Forum II** is on “**BRI General Theory (BRIGT) & Greater Bay Area (GBA)**”. It will use the BRIGT to explain the “Vision & Realization” of the BRI through the BRI Triangle and its IDL/ILI Methodology. The session will examine the GBA and the role designated for Hong Kong in it under the BRI. There will be case studies on the many challenges ahead in the process of realization.

The Moderator for this 1st Session will be Mr. Wong Cho Hor of Five Oceans Maritime Ltd., and Guest Moderator to be further advised, with other members of the Panel of Moderators and Advisors in attendance.
