



MARINE INSURANCE WORKSHOPS First (1st) Session on Tuesday 5th November 2019

This is a series of four bi-monthly workshops focusing on “Marine Insurance”, and is jointly organized by The Hong Kong Logistics Management Staff Association (HKLMSA), China Taiping Insurance (HK) Company Limited and C.Y.
