Embracing the Changing Dynamics

The subtle yet “future-significant” changes that have the potential to affect the way business is conducted, are often overlooked. Understanding the impact of forthcoming, or even “future-possible” financial and environmental regulations, the rise of populist & inward-looking leadership trends, increasing distrust among nations, reductions in the seaborne trade multiplier, staged impact of BRI, digitalisation, analytics etc., are critical for strategic decision-making processes.

The rapid rate of change is further expected to cause disruptions even in the maritime industry, traditionally known for its resistance and reactive nature. The talk emphasises upon “Think-Economic” & “Think-Risk” concepts with real life examples, before opening the floor for joint discussion. Some of the topics that will be covered include:

- Brief introduction to drivers of freight equilibrium
- IFRS 16 - Changing landscape and its significant business implications
- Environmental regulations: identifying the weakest yet critical links
- Moving towards Alternate Dispute Resolution methods
- Short-, medium- and long-term impact of the Belt Road Initiative
- Change in the make-up of GDP and corresponding impact on international trade
- Think-Economic & Think-Risk concepts
